## Shaykh Ibn Bāz: Regarding Takfīr of the One Who Speaks of Earth's Motion



## Shaykh 'Abd al-'Azīz bin Bāz (ﷺ) said: "

"As for the one who said that the Earth [moves] in orbit and the Sun also moves, his saying is lighter than the one who speaks with the stationary Sun. However, this in itself is a clear error and opposes the preceding verses, sensory perception and outward reality. It is an avenue to the saying that the Sun does not move. Allāh has already made clear in the aforementioned verses that He placed the mountains in the Earth so that it does not move with them and [the word] *mayd* means movement (*ḥarakah*), shaking (*iḍṭirāb*) and motion (*dawrān*) as the scholars of exegesis and imāms of the [Arabic] language have textually stated. In the takfīr of the one who speaks

with this saying there is some observation to be made because the evidences relayed regarding the stationary Earth and its rest and the absence of its orbit are not as clear as the evidences relayed regarding the motion of the sun and the absence of its rest. It is also because those who affirm the orbital motion of the Earth present doubts which obligate the avoidance of [ascribing] disbelief to the one who spoke with that. But there is no doubt about the disbelief of the one who rejects the orbital motion of the Sun due to the clear definitive evidences regarding it."
